ENTRANCE TO ANGOLA FOR NATIONALS AND FOREIGNERS

UPDATED RULES FOR THE PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF THE SPREAD OF THE VIRUS SARS-COV-2 AND COVID-19

FROM THE PRESIDENTIAL DECREE N°10/21, 8th JANUARY 2021

(...)

Article 6

(Defense and health control of borders)

1. The borders of the Republic of Angola remain closed, and the entrances and exits of the national territory are subject to health control defined by the competent authorities, in accordance with the International Health Regulations and the National Health Regulations.
2. Without prejudice to the provisions in the previous number, are allowed entrances and exit to national territory for the purposes of:
 - a) Return to the national territory of nationals and foreign citizens with Angolan resident permit as well as foreign citizens holding work visas;
 - b) Entry of foreign professionals who provide services in Angola, both for public and private entities;
 - c) The return of foreign nationals to their respective Countries;
 - (d) Official travel to and from Angola;
 - e) Entry and exit of cargo, merchandise and postal orders;
 - (f) Humanitarian aid;
 - (g) Medical emergencies;
 - (h) Technical scales;
 - i) Entry and exit of Diplomatic and Consular Personnel;
3. Without prejudice to other formalities, the entry and exit of the national territory, in accordance with the preceding paragraph, do not require any type of authorization, depending on the pre-test taken before boarding of the SARS-CoV-2 virus, with negative result, carried out in the 72 hours prior to the trip.
4. Where there are serious risks of importing the SARS-CoV-2 virus into the national territory, the relevant Ministerial Departments may determine the temporary closure or suspension of air traffic, land, sea and inland waterway traffic with specific Countries.

(Translation of corpses)

(...)

Article 9

The international and interprovincial translation of corpses whose cause of death is COVID-19 is prohibited.

(...)

Article 10

(Scheduled flights)

1. In effect of Articles 6 and 7 of this Diploma, regular national and international flights shall be permitted and shall be limited to the minimum necessary and appropriate to the epidemiological situation.
2. For boarding international flights to and from Angola, it is mandatory to present an RT-PCR test with negative result, made in the 72 hours before the trip with no authorization being required.
3. For boarding domestic flights, it is mandatory to present a serological test with a negative result, made within 72 hours before the trip, with no authorization being required.
4. The Ministerial Departments responsible for the matter shall define the gradual cadence of flights, their schedule and the rules to be observed by everyone involved.

(...)

Article 11

(Quarantine)

1. For nationals, foreigner's residents and Diplomatic members accredited in Angola from outside the country, home quarantine is mandatory.
2. For cases of non-resident foreign nationals from outside the country and with their own residence, compliance with household quarantine is mandatory; unless the health authorities consider that there are no conditions for this purpose.
3. Citizens subject to household quarantine sign a term of responsibility, as defined by the health authorities.
4. The quarantine of the household quarantine shall be considered to be completed with the issuance of the discharge bond by the competent health authority, which takes place after the SARS-CoV-2 test with negative results performed at least 7 days after the beginning of the home quarantine.
5. Where the health authorities consider that there are no conditions for home quarantine, in particular the observance of physical distancing, institutional quarantine shall be determined.
6. Without prejudice to criminal liability, under the law, the violation of the household quarantine is sanctioned with the fine that varies between the Kz: 150,000.00 (one hundred and fifty thousand Kwanzas) and the Kz: 250,000.00 (two hundred and fifty thousand Kwanzas), in addition to swift into institutional quarantine.
